The bill entitled, an Act to repeal, amend and re-enact the Act entitled, an Act to revive the Act of incorporation of the own of Salisbury in Somerset and Worcester counties, chapter 356 of Public Local Laws for Somerset county, passed March 10th, 1864, and to add new sections thereto, ratifying and confirming certain acts of the commissioners of said town and for other purposes;

3rd. Amend section 3, 5th line, by inserting after the words "seventy-eight," the words "of Article 19, sub-title Salisbury."

4th. Amend section 4, 3rd line, by inserting after the words "seventy-four" the words "of article 19, sub-title Salisbury;" also same line after the word "repealed," insert the word "amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows."

5th. Amend section 6, third line, by inserting after the word "Somerset" the words "or Worcester."

6th. Amend section 8, 4th line, by inserting after the word "appointed," the words "and qualified;" also in same line after the word "Somerset," insert the words "and Worcester."
