

CHAPTER 370.

AN ACT entitled, an Act to provide for the payment of the claim of Francis A. Prevost, an assistant clerk in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city under the administration thereof by Edward Dowling, late Chief Clerk. Passed Mar. 2, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Asembly of Maryland,* That Alford Mace, the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to adjust the compensation account of Francis A. Prevost, Assistant Clerk in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city during the administration of the said office by Edward Dowling, former Clerk thereof, and when so adjusted to pay to the said Francis A. Prevost such sum of money as he may find to be due him for the service so rendered by him out of any surplus funds accrued or accruing in said office, and which would otherwise be payable into the Treasury for the use of the State; *provided,* that the allowance to the said Francis A. Prevost shall not exceed the sum of one thousand and forty-five dollars. Clerk authorized to adjust.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall go into effect from the day of the passage thereof. Proviso.
