

Sec. 21. *And be it enacted*, That in case of a partial destruction by fire the loss shall be determined by assessors appointed as follows: The person whose property is insured shall have the privilege of selecting one disinterested person, and in ten days thereafter the Board of Directors of this company shall select another; should these two persons disagree in their valuation of a loss, they shall select another disinterested person, and the award of a majority shall be final, and the company shall pay the same within sixty days after the date of their award. Loss in certain cases.

Sec. 22. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 393.

AN ACT to repeal an Act entitled, an Act to authorize Mrs. Margaret Sherwood, wife of Hugh Sherwood, of Talbot county, to close a public road leading through her lands in said county, passed at the January session of the General Assembly, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and twenty-three. Passed Mar. 18, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an Act entitled, an Act to authorize Mrs. Margaret Sherwood, wife of Hugh Sherwood of Talbot county, to close a public road leading through her land in said county, passed at the January session of the General Assembly, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and twenty-three, be and the same is hereby repealed. Act repealed.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the said Mrs. Margaret Sherwood, within sixty days after the passage of this Act, to re-open said road, and re-establish the same in the same order and condition as it was in when the same was Road to be opened.
