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CHAPTER 414.

AN ACT to refund a sum of money paid into the State Treasury erroneously by John V. Lowe of Talbot County, one of the Collectors of Taxes for said County.

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby required to pay to John V. Lowe, of Talbot county, a Collector of State Taxes for the said county, for the years eighteen hundred and sixty and eighteen hundred and sixty-one, the sum of ten dollars and eighty-nine cents, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.

AN ACT to repeal the Fourth Section of the Forty-Third Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Habeas Corpus, and re-enact the following sections in lieu thereof.
