Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby required to pay to John V. Lowe, of Talbot county, a Collector of State Taxes for the said county, for the years eighteen hundred and sixty and eighteen hundred and sixty-one, the sum of ten dollars and eighty-nine cents, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.
