A bill entitled an Act to repeal sub section 5 of chapter 194 of Laws of Maryland, passed January session 1865, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact sections 5, 26 and 27 of an Act passed January session 1864, chapter 346 entitled, an Act to amend article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the leasing of the State Tobacco warehouses and the inspection of tobacco, and to re-enact the same; also to repeal sections 9, 11, 12, 15, 17, 18, 19, 22, 25, 26, 27 and 28 of
