Leave was granted to Messrs. Bowie, Trail and Tome, to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to require the county commissioners of Frederick county to pay for the printing and publishing ordered by the late officers of Registration in said county.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill to authorize the coporate authorities of the city of Baltimore to appropriate a sum of money for the relief of the suffering South, and to provide for the payment thereof.

Leave was granted to Messrs. Waters, Vickers and Holton to introduce a bill to incorporate Chester Lodge, No. 115, Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons.
