The resolution was read the second time.

Reported it without amendment,

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Earle, from the Committee on Finance, to which was referred the bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 106, 107, 108, 109 and 110, of article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, revenue and taxes, and relating to tax on Executors and Administrators commissions ;

Reported unfavorably thereon,

After the word "Montgomery," in the 17th line, add the words "for purchase money in the hands of the original mortgage, or his executors, administrators and legal representatives, in case of the death of the mortgagee," and strike out the words "for whatever object or purpose the same may be executed ;"
