Resolved, That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, in addition to the twenty-five thousand already appropriated be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the purchase of a suitable residence for the accommodation of the Executive of the State.

Resolved, That upon the execution to the State by Wm. H. Tuck, of a good and sufficient title to the houses and grounds, by him offered, (to be approved by the Governor) the Treasurer shall upon the warrant of the Comptroller, pay to the said Wm. H. Tuck, the sum of forty thousand dollars, as above appropriated and referred to as the consideration money therefor.
