A bill entitled, an Act to repeal the Act passed January session, 1865, chapter 114, entitled, an Act to repeal the 10th section of Article 11, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the oath of Attorney's and other practitioners of law, and to enact a substitute therefor, and to repeal the 10th section, of the 11th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, title, Attorney's at Law and Attorney's in fact, subtitle, Attorney's at Law, and to enact a section in lieu of the said 10th section;

Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays, with the proposed amendments;"
