General, a Judge Advocate General, a Paymaster General, a Quartermaster General, a Surgeon General, and a Commissary General, who shall rank as Brigadier General; each of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, and shall hold their respective offices during the pleasure of the Governor;"
