Further proceedings under the call were dispensed with.

The question recurred upon the adoption of the motion submitted by Mr. Tome, and it was

Determined in the affirmative.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates returned the bill entitled, an Act to amend the charter of the Philadelphia and Baltimore Central Railroad Company;

Endorsed, "passed by year and nays with the proposed amendments."
