The undersigned, committee appointed to investigate how the amendments were made to the bill relative to the election of Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, respectfully report that at the time of engrossing the bill it was suggested that the omission of the word "second," was a clerical error, and supposing such to be the case, and in order to make the meaning of the section conform to the other sections of the bill, the word "second" was inserted. That in our opinion, it was an improper alteration without the knowledge of the Senate, but we are unanimously satisfied there was no criminal intention whatever upon the part of either the parties who suggested or made the alteration.
