Leave granted to report a bill to repeal section 99 of article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, title, sub-title "Larceny," 118; bill reported, and read the first time, 152; read the second and third times and passed, 260; sent to the House, *ib.*; returned passed, 322.

Leave granted to report a bill to repeal the following sections of article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, title, to wit: sections 69, 70, 71 and 72, sub-title "Importing Convicts or Slaves;" sections 75 and 77, sub-title "Incendiary and Ob-scene Publications;" sections 94, 95, 96 and 97, sub-title "Kidnapping;" section 128, sub-title "Marrying Unlawfully;" section 141, sub-title "Murder;" sections 146, 147, 148, 149 and 150, sub-title "Negroes;" sections 153 and 154, sub-title "Passes to Negroes;" section 168, sub-title "Religious Meetings," and sections 174, 175, 176 and 177, sub-title "Runaways," 119; read the second time, 152, and passed, 235; sent to the House, *ib.*; returned passed, 321.

Bill reported to repeal section 152 of the 30th article of the Code of Public General Laws, title, sub-title "Fornication with Negroes," and to re-enact the same with amendment, and read the first time, 153; laid over informally, 215; considered, amendments proposed and negatived, 254, 255; read the second and third times and passed, 256; sent to the House, *ib.*

Leave granted to report a bill to add additional sections to the 13th article of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, providing for the punishment of certain offences relating to public offices, 217; bill reported, and read the first time, 248; read the second time, 402; read the third time and rejected, 647; notice of reconsideration, *ib.*

Leave granted to report a bill to repeal section 8, of article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, and to re-enact the same with amendments, 368; bill reported, and read the first and second times, 396; amended, read the third time and passed, 396; sent to the House, *ib.*; message asking return of bill, 527; bill returned, 560; reported with amendment, which was adopted, 614; read the second and third times, and passed, *ib.*; sent to the House, *ib.*
