This Commission was appointed at the request of the Executive Committee of the American Flying Club of Baltimore. The Commission is requested to study modern aviation conditions and recommend legislation to safeguard and promote aviation in Maryland. The General Assembly of 1922 passed a joint resolution legalizing the Commission.

The Commission was appointed by Governor Albert C. Ritchie on April 24, 1920, by authorization of Chapter 92, Acts of 1920, to complete the work begun by the Maryland Council of Defense in the collection and compilation of a permanent record of all sons of Maryland in the service of the United States in the World War in the Military, Naval and Marine forces, or who otherwise rendered conspicuous public service during the period of the recent war.
