State Employees' Standard Salary Board

- Established By:** Md. Code Ann., art. 64A, § 26.  
**Head:** Chairman—commissioner of personnel.  
**Members:** Commissioner of personnel, *ex officio*. Chairman of City Service Commission of Baltimore City, *ex officio*. Member selected by governor from list of three names submitted by Maryland Classified Employees Association. 2 members appointed by governor from general public.  
**Term:** 3 members hold 6-year terms.  
**Removal:** Membership on board is automatically terminated if members from general public become an officer or employee of State. Md. Code Ann., art. 64A, § 26(g). No other statutory provision.  
**Employee:** Chairman designates a regular employee of office to be a secretary of board.  
**Function:** Considers materials developed by the Commission of Personnel and prepares and recommends to the governor a pay plan for all classes of positions.

Employees' Retirement System

03.01.00.01

- Established By:** Md. Code Ann., art. 73B, § 2.  
**Head:** Board of Trustees selects chairman.  
**Members:** State budget director *ex officio*. Comptroller *ex officio*. Commissioner of personnel *ex officio*. Treasurer *ex officio*.  
1 State employee appointed by Board of Public Works.  
2 employees selected by state system of employees.  
**Term:** 3 employees hold 4-year terms—staggered.  
**Removal:** No statutory provision.  
**Employees:** Md. Code Ann., art. 73B, § 12(9)—Board of Trustees selects a secretary who need not be a board member.
