Md. Code Ann., art. 101, § 6—All employees are appointed by Com-

mission and all are under the merit system.

Function:

Commission administers the Workman's Compensation Law; hears contested cases and holds hearings throughout the State; receives reports of accidents and jurdicates claims for compensation arising under the law; and investigates companies and firms which fail to

carry insurance under the terms of the Act.
