Function:	To administer the optometry laws of the State and the practice of optometry, through examination, licensing, and registration.

State Board of Cosmetologists

Established By:	Md. Code Ann., Art. 43, § 539.
Head:	Chairman elected by the Board.
Members:	3, appointed by the governor; each must have five years practical experience and possess other specific qualifications.
Term:	3 years, staggered.
Employees:	26 employees, including inspectors.
Function:	To license, examine and register persons engaged in, or teaching hairdressing and beauty culture in the State.
