

CONSTITUTIONAL REVISION STUDY DOCUMENTS

Head: Chairman.
Members: 5, appointed by the governor from list submitted by Veterinary Association.
Term: Five years, staggered.
Removal: No statutory provision.
Employees: 4 employees, including an executive secretary selected by the Board.
Function: To examine and license veterinary medical practitioners; may hold hearings and institute judicial proceedings in instances of illegal practice.

Board of Medical Examiners

Established By: Md. Code Ann., art. 43, §§ 119-49.
Head: President selected by the Board.
Members: 8, elected from and by the members of the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty (State Medical Society) who are in active practice in the State.
Term: 4 years, staggered—two elected each year.
Removal: By governor after notice and hearing for misconduct in office, immorality, neglect of duty or any other cause.
Employees: 4 employees, including executive secretary selected by the Board.
Function: To test and license physicians for practice in the State. Determine qualifications of licensing and may revoke licenses for certain causes.

Head: Chairman.
Members: 3, appointed by the judges of the Court of Appeals.
Term: 3 years, staggered.
Removal: No statutory provision.
Employees: None.
