Term: For the certified public accountants, 3 years, staggered, for the other 2, 2 years.

Removal: By the governor after notice and hearing.

Employees: 2 employees.

Function: To examine and register public accountants and public accountancy partnerships certified to practice in Maryland.

Board of Osteopathic Examiners

Established By: Md. Code Ann., art. 43, § 467.

Head: President elected by the Board.

Members: 5, appointed by the governor from a full list of members in good standing of the Maryland Osteopathic Association.

Term: 3 years, staggered.

Removal: No statutory provision.

Employees: None.

Function: To license osteopaths for practice in the State.

Maryland Board of Pharmacy

Head: President elected by the Board.
