§ 38 Clerks:
(Continued)

Clerk of Superior Court:

Records all papers, such as deeds, as prescribed by law; is Clerk for Supreme Bench unless changed by law; has custody of papers of Baltimore County Court if papers "have relation" to the City of Baltimore.

§ 39 *Additional Judges for Supreme Bench:*

Provided for by law and elected by voters.

Trial without jury—provided for by law or rule of the Supreme Bench in cases where no application within reasonable time. [Added, 1898.]

Jurisdiction of Baltimore courts may be altered by law.
