GOVERNING-COORDINATING BOARDS—Continued

⁶³ Of the 32 members, six are appointed by the Governor with confirmation of the Senate, six are elected by the delegates from county agricultural societies, six are delegates from county industrial societies, nine are alumni elected by the alumni of the University, and five are ex officio.

⁶⁴ Of the 32, nine must be alumni.

⁶⁵ The Governor, the Commissioner of Agriculture, the Commissioner of Education, and the President of the University are ex officio members.

⁶⁶ The 14 members appointed by the Governor must meet the following requirements: at least one-third must be alumni of the University; at least one-third must be members of the principal minority political party of the State; five must be residents of, or have principal offices located in counties as follows: two, Knox County; two, Shelby County; and one, Weakly County; and there must be one from each of the nine congressional districts.

⁶⁷ Members must be qualified voters, selected from different parts of the states.

⁶⁸ Superintendent of Public Instruction.

⁶⁹ Of the 16 members appointed by the Governor, 11 must be alumni of the University, at least 13 must be selected from the State at large, and not more than three may be nonresident alumni.

⁷¹ Not more than two members may be appointed who are residents of the same county.
