Sec. 3. All annual appointments of civil officers in this State, shall be made in the third week of January in every year in the same manner as the Constitution and form of government now directs.

Proposed by Act of 1836, chapter 197. Ratified 1837.

Sec. 14. The Governor shall nominate, and by and with the advise and consent of the Senate, shall appoint all officers of the State whose offices are or may be created by law, and whose appointment shall not be otherwise provided for by the Constitution and form of government, or by any laws consistent with the Constitution and form of Government Provided that this act shall not be deemed or construed to impair in any manner, the validity of the commissions of such persons as shall be in office under previous executive appointment whenthis act shall go into operation, or to alter, abridge, or change the tenure, quality or duration of the same, or of any of them.
