Ratified 1823.</b></p> <p>St. Mary's County shall be divided into five separate election districts, and the additional district shall be taken and laid off from the fourth election district as they are numbered.</p> <p><b>Proposed by Act of 1822, chapter 116. Ratified 1823.</b></p> <p>[The appointed commissioners are] hereby authorized and appointed, or a majority of them, commissioners to lay off and divide anew the fourth and fifth election districts, or the fifth district only, whichever they deem will tend most to the convenience of the voters in said districts in Anne Arundel County, into not exceeding three separate election districts. . . .</p> <p><b>Proposed by Act of 1824, chapter 67.
