Sec. 1. Upon the resignation of a Senator during the recess of the Senate, communicated in writing to the Governor, or upon the death of any Senator during the recess, it shall be the duty of the Governor to issue a warrant of election, to supply vacancies thus created in the same manner as the President of the Senate for the time being is authorized to do, in virtue of an act to amend the constitution and form of government of the State of Maryland, Chapter 197, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty six, and confirmed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty seven.

Sec. 2. In all cases of resignation or death as aforesaid the elections to supply the vacancies shall take place at the time and places of the annual election of delegates, unless such resignation or death shall occur between the first day of September and the meeting of the General Assembly in any year, in which event. elections shall be held at such time, as shall be directed by the Governor, with such notice as is provided by
