make or cause to be made, a true and just ac-
count of said administration, at or before
the day of next, and all the
rest and residue of the said goods, chattels, and
credits which shall be found remaining upon
the said administration account, the same be-
ing first examined and allowed of by the judge
or judges for the time being of the said court,
shall deliver and pay unto the person or persons
appointed by law to receive the same; then
this obligation to be void, and of none effect,
or else to remain in full force and virtue.
