goods, chattels, debts and credits of late of

shall well and truly

fecure and collect the estate of the faid deceased, whether it be goods, chattels, debts or credits, and shall make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory thereof, and the fame shall exhibit into the office for probate of wills &c. at Annapolis, with all convenient speed, together with his reasonable account of fuch his collection, and shall at all times hereafter indemnify and fave harmless his faid lordship, his judges, and all other his officers and ministers, from all persons having, or pretending to have any right, title, or interest to the faid goods, chattels, debts and credits, and shall also pay all such reasonable charges and fees, as have arisen, or shall arise or become due to any his lordship's officers and others from the faid

on the account of the faid deceased or his estate, that then this obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
