D. under pain of his allegiance to our fovereign lord the king, and fealty to us, be and appear personally before our commissary general and judge for probate of wills &c. in our prerogative court to be held at the city of Annapolis, the second next, and nevertheless Tuesday of if in the mean time you can find the faid C. D. you attach him, fo that you have him before our faid judge upon the day aforesaid, to answer unto us, as well of a certain contempt against us by him committed, as to fuch other matters and things, as shall then and there be laid to his charge, and further to perform and abide fuch
