SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That one at least of the said commissioners shall reside in the city of Baltimore, and in lieu of the salary heretofore given to said commissioners, the commissioner or commissioners residing in the said city, shall hereafter be entitled to receive at the rate of ten per centum; and the said commissioners residing in the county at the rate of seven and a half per centum each, upon the amount raised by the lottery system; Provided, that the compensation to the commissioner or commissioners residing in the said city, shall, in no event, exceed the sum of two thousand dollars each, in any one year; and the compensation to the commissioners residing in the county, in no event to exceed the sum of fifteen hundred dollars each, in any one year.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, dent condi- That as soon as the consent of the government of the United States shall have been obtained as hereinafter provided, that part of the United States road commonly called the National road, within the limits of the state of Maryland, shall be taken under the care of the state of Maryland, and the governor and council of the state shall be, and they are hereby authorized to appoint a superintendent of that part of said road lying within the limits of this state; who shall hold his office for three years from the date of his commission, and who shall at the time of his appointment, and during his continuance in office, reside in Allegany county, whose duty it shall be to exercise all reasonable vigilance and diligence in the care thereof; which superintendent after his appointment shall have full power and authority to build toll-houses, and erect toll-gates at suitable distances:
