

and all the money paid for advertisements in the newspapers directed in this act, with an interest on the amount so paid, of ten per centum per annum; then in that event and from thenceforth, all title or colour of title, derived by such purchaser or purchasers, by and in virtue of their purchase, at such collector's sale, shall be utterly null and void, and the title of the owner or owners, whose interest may have been sold, as complete as if no such sale had been made.

Right to redeem.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That if the purchaser or purchasers, at collector's sales as aforesaid, do and shall deposit with the clerk of Allegany county, copies of the advertisements required by the first section of this act, together with the affidavits of the editors who have published the same, that the same have been published according to the provisions of the first section of this act, to be recorded by the clerk of Allegany county, whose duty it is hereby made to record the same, that such record shall be good and sufficient evidence that the provisions of this law have been complied with.

AN ACT for the more effectual Collection of the County Charges in Allegany County.—1834, ch. 334.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be the duty of the collector of the county charges of Allegany county, on or before the first Monday of March, in each and every year hereafter, to return a list of all non-residents' land, and others on which there is no personal property, from which the tax can be made, with the name of the owner or owners, name of the land, number of lots, with the amount of taxes due thereon, whether for one or more years, or where the owners of said land have no personal property within said county.

Amounts due, &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the said commissioners to cause a list of said lands to be published, for the term of three weeks successively, in the two papers published in the town of Cumberland, one daily paper published in the city of Baltimore, and one daily paper in the city of Washington, expressing in said list, the name or names of the owners, the names of the lands, and number of lots, the amount of tax due thereon, and all costs, with the number of acres, notifying the said absentees that unless the taxes, and all costs thereon, shall be paid to the collector of Allegany county, for the time being, or his agent in Baltimore, on or before the first day of June then following, the said lands, or such part thereof as shall be sufficient to pay the county charges, and all costs thereon, shall be sold at public vendue, for the payment thereof, and it shall be the duty of the said collector to procure, from the editors of the several papers in which said list shall be pub-
