

AN ACT for the encouragement of Primary Schools in Anne Arundel County.—1827, ch. 173.

School fund
to credit of
commis-
sioners.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the school fund of Anne Arundel county, arising under the act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road leading to Cumberland, and for the extension of the charters of the several banks of the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes, and its several supplements, is hereby assigned and appropriated for the encouragement and support of public instruction, and placed under the direction and control of the commissioners of primary schools for said county, and the treasurer of the western shore is hereby authorized and directed, to place in the Farmers Bank of Maryland, to the credit of the commissioners of primary schools aforesaid, the dividends or profits arising on the school fund already invested, and also all moneys which from time to time may hereafter be received into the treasury belonging to the school fund of said county.

AN ACT to repeal part of an Act, entitled, an Act for the encouragement of Primary Schools in Anne Arundel County.—1828, ch. 55.

Repeal.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act for the encouragement of primary schools in Anne Arundel county, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, chapter one hundred and seventy-three, excepting the second section thereof, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Moneys to
be invested.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the treasurer of the western shore be, and he is hereby authorized and required, to invest in some safe and productive fund, so much of the moneys now in the treasury to the credit of the school fund of said county, as shall procure a capital or principal stock of five thousand dollars, which said stock shall be held for the use and benefit of primary schools in said county, and the dividends or profits arising on said stock, as they arise, shall be deposited in the Farmers Bank of Maryland, to the credit of the commissioners of primary schools in said county.

Treasurer
to deposite
moneys.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the treasurer of the western shore be, and he is hereby authorized and required, to deposite in the Farmers Bank of Maryland, to the credit of the aforesaid commissioners, the residue of the moneys belonging to the school fund of said county, which shall remain in the treasury after making the aforesaid investment, which said residue, and all other moneys deposited or to be deposited, to the credit of said commissioners, shall be by them applied under the provisions of the act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools throughout this state, passed at December
