

who shall extend the limits of direct taxation within the said city, so far as the same is settled, built or improved, and in which the usual regulations for watching and lighting or cleansing the streets are or ought to be applied, and the said mayor and city council of Baltimore shall have full power to assess, levy and collect, any direct tax within such limits, when so ascertained and extended; *Provided*, that the commissioners who may be appointed as aforesaid, shall be disinterested persons, and non-residents of the city of Baltimore, and not holders of property therein. Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That from and after the passage of this act, the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall be, and they are hereby empowered; to pass all ordinances which they may deem necessary to carry into effect, and not inconsistent with the provisions of the preceding section. Ordinances.

SEC. 3, 4. Repealed by 1831, ch. 214.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That all acts, or part of acts, inconsistent with, or contrary to the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

A SUPPLEMENT to the ACT, entitled, an additional Act relating to the City of Baltimore, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty, chapter one hundred and thirty-nine.—1831, ch. 214.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the third and fourth sections of the act, to which this is a supplement, be and the same are hereby repealed. Sections repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow such sum or sums of money, and to such amounts, not exceeding one million of dollars, for the use and improvement of the city of Baltimore, and of the property of the corporation, and to aid in the construction of any useful public work authorized by any law of the state, or ordinance of the said mayor and city council, and on such terms as they, from time to time, shall deem proper and necessary, any thing in any former law to the contrary notwithstanding. Corporation authorized to borrow.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall have full power, from time to time, to provide by ordinance, for the ascertainment and valuation of all property, real and personal, within the said city, and all kind of estate and interest in any such property, liable to taxation under the constitution and laws of this state, and to provide for the collection of all such taxes as they are authorized by law, and shall deem necessary, to impose on the same.
