SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That if any person in the city of Penalty on Baltimore, other than the two inspectors appointed by the go- others than inspectors vernor and council, shall inspect, mark or brand, any fish in marking said city, he shall forfeit and pay one hundred dollars for each and every such offence, which said fine shall be recovered and appropriated in the same manner as fines are recovered from persons offending against an act passed at December session. eighteen hundred and twenty-five, relating to the inspection of salted fish brought to the city of Baltimore.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts of Reneal. assembly inconsistent with, or contrary to, the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

An Acr to reduce the rate of Inspection of Fish in the City of Baltimore. 1830, ch. 140.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, Duty of That from and after the first day of May next, it shall be the duty of the inspectors of fish in the city of Baltimore, or either of them, to brand each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of herrings, shad or mackerel fish, that he or they may hereafter inspect, with the word 'Spring;' Provided, that he or they may Proviso. believe that the said mackerel fish was caught in the spring of the year in which the same may be by him or them inspected.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for Allowance. any inspector of fish in the city of Baltimore, to charge, or in any wise receive for inspecting of each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of shad or mackerel fish, ten cents; for each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of herrings, three cents. and no more.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That if any one or more of the Penalty for inspectors of fish shall violate the provisions of this act, the violation of same shall be liable to indictment in Baltimore city court, and on conviction shall, for every such offence, forfeit and pay the sum of fifty dollars, the one-half to be for the use of the informer, and the other half for the use of the state.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That any act, or the part of any Repeal. act, inconsistent with, or repugnant to this act, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
