

fish, to be inspectors for the city of Baltimore, and by whom all salted fish, hereafter brought to the city of Baltimore for sale, shall be inspected.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any part of the acts of assembly which compels the inspectors of salted fish in said city to pay a license of seventy-five dollars each, to the corporation of Baltimore, be, and the same is hereby repealed. Acts repealed as relates to payment for license.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if any person in the city of Baltimore, other than the two inspectors appointed by the governor and council, shall inspect, mark or brand, any fish in said city, he shall forfeit and pay one hundred dollars for each and every such offence, which said fine shall be recovered and appropriated in the same manner as fines are recovered from persons offending against an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-five, relating to the inspection of salted fish brought to the city of Baltimore. Penalty on others than inspectors marking fish.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts of assembly inconsistent with, or contrary to, the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

AN ACT to reduce the rate of Inspection of Fish in the City of Baltimore. 1830, ch. 140.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the first day of May next, it shall be the duty of the inspectors of fish in the city of Baltimore, or either of them, to brand each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of herrings, shad or mackerel fish, that he or they may hereafter inspect, with the word 'Spring;' *Provided*, that he or they may believe that the said mackerel fish was caught in the spring of the year in which the same may be by him or them inspected. Duty of inspectors. Provide.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful for any inspector of fish in the city of Baltimore, to charge, or in any wise receive for inspecting of each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of shad or mackerel fish, ten cents; for each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce of herrings, three cents, and no more. Allowance.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if any one or more of the inspectors of fish shall violate the provisions of this act, the same shall be liable to indictment in Baltimore city court, and on conviction shall, for every such offence, forfeit and pay the sum of fifty dollars, the one-half to be for the use of the informer, and the other half for the use of the state. Penalty for violation of act.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That any act, or the part of any act, inconsistent with, or repugnant to this act, be, and the same is hereby repealed. Repeal.
