Baltimore, which oath or affirmation, (as the case may be,) when taken and reduced to writing shall be lodged in the office of the register of said city to be by him recorded.

Compensation to arbitrators. SEC. 17. And be it enacted, That each of said arbitrators shall, for every such arbitration as aforesaid, in which he shall act upon, be entitled to receive the sum of one dollar, to be paid by the person or persons making such appeal, in case the decision appealed from shall be affirmed, or in case of the reversal of such decision, then by the inspector making the same.

An Acr Supplementary to an Act regulating the Inspection of Green Hides and Skins, in the City of Baltimore.—1832, ch. 47.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it appears that the act to which this is a supplement, as engrossed and printed, provides that it shall go into force on the first day of March following the passage thereof, and the operation of said act is thereby delayed for the period of nearly one year, and contrary to the intention of the general assembly, that intention having been that said act should be in force, from and after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-two; therefore,

Annual act now in force. Sec. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said act be, and the same is hereby declared to be in full force and effect from and after the passage of this act.

Appointment confirmed. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That any appointment of inspector of green hides and skins, in the city of Baltimore, that shall have been made by the governor and council before the passing of this act, shall be deemed and taken to be valid and effectual as if said act had gone into full force and operation from the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-two.

A SUPPLEMENT to the Act, entitled, an Act regulating the Inspection of Green Hides and Skins, in the City of Baltimore, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and forty-five.—1835, ch. 270.

Estimate of damages.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be the duty of the inspectors of green hides and skins, in the city of Baltimore, to keep a regular minute of the damage of each and every hide and skin slaughtered by the several butchers of the city of Baltimore, and so report the same monthly to an agent or collector to be appointed by the mayor and city council of Baltimore, to whom he shall give bond with security.

Collect and pay over.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said agent or collector so appointed, shall collect from the butchers, the amount of fines so incurred, and pay the same over to the city register, quarterly.

Pay for inspection. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the amount of inspection on all hides and skins that are damaged, shall be paid by the
