SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the ninth, tenth, eleventh Sections and twelfth sections of said act, be and the same are hereby repealed. repealed.

A SUPPLEMENT to an Act, entitled, an Act for the Appointment of Lime Inspectors for the City of Baltimore.—1836, ch. 301.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Act of 1832. from and after the first day of March next, all such parts of the ch. 269, extended. act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirtytwo, chapter two hundred and sixty-nine, as require the inspection of lime brought to the city of Baltimore by land or water, shall also apply to all lime made within the limits of said city.
