Brigadiergeneral and others. general, in the seventh section of the act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-six, the oldest commanding officer in rank in said division, to give the notice for the meeting of said officers for that purpose, and before any brigadier-general of said second light brigade or any division staff officer of the first light division, or any brigade staff officer of the second light brigade, or any officer of the fifty-third regiment of volunteer infantry, shall be commissioned, each and every of said officers, shall be recommended to the consideration of the governor and council, in the manner directed in the aforesaid seventh section of the act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter fifty-six, for the recommendation of officers of the several grades therein mentioned.

Major, when to be commissioned. SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That whenever three companies have been commissioned in said fifty-third regiment, the governor and council shall commission a major of said regiment, he being previously recommended to their consideration as aforesaid, and when the number of companies in said fifty-third regiment, exceeds five, the governor and council shall commission the usual field and regimental staff officers for said regiment, they having been previously recommended to their consideration as aforesaid.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That said first light division, and the brigades, regiments and companies attached to it, shall continue to have all the rights and privileges, secured to uniformed volunteer corps, by the act of eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and eighty-eight, or by any supplement thereto.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That in lieu of the parades directed by the said act of eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and eighty-eight, or by any supplement thereto, the militia of the city of Baltimore shall in each and every year hereafter parade for exercise, discipline and inspection, as follows: The first light division on the first Monday in May, the first Monday in June, the twelfth day of September, and the second Monday in October; the artillery brigade on the first Tuesday in May, the first Tuesday in June, the twelfth day of September, and the second Tuesday in October; the third brigade on the first Wednesday in May, the first Wednesday in June, the twelfth day of September, and the first Wednesday in October; the fourteenth brigade, on the first Thursday in May, the first Thursday in June, the twelfth day of September, and the first Thursday in October; and the said parades in May shall be company parades; the parades in June shall be regimental parades, for inspection; and the parades in October shall be brigade parades, and shall take place at one o'clock, P. M.; and the parades on the twelfth day of September
