

by reason of the death or resignation of a collector or collectors previously appointed, or of the neglect or refusal of any such collector to give bond in the manner and at the time required by the said commissioners, any laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

A SUPPLEMENT to an ACT, entitled, an Act to provide for the appointment of Collectors of the County Tax, in and for the City and County of Baltimore, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-three.—1836, ch. 228.

There is no such act in 1823. It is presumed that the law referred to, is 1823, ch. 53, entitled 'a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for a new assessment, and to appoint collectors of the county tax, in and for the city and county of Baltimore.'

*Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That* it shall be the duty of the commissioners of Baltimore county for the collection of the county tax, to divide said county into any number of collection districts, not exceeding five, in their discretion, and particularly to describe the boundaries and number of each district, and to record the same among the records of said commissioners; and the said commissioners of the county shall annually hereafter appoint one collector of the county tax for each collection district, designating the number of the district in the several bonds to be filed with the said commissioners, which said collectors when so appointed, before they proceed to act, shall give bond and security as directed by the act to which this is a supplement.
