An Acr relating to certain Claims on Baltimore County.-1835, ch. 102.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, All existing That all claims upon Baltimore county, for which levies have demanded been heretofore made, and for which payments respectively, within one shall not be demanded from the treasurer of the county within forfeited. one year after the passage of this act, shall be declared to be forfeited to the use of the county, and the moneys levied as aforesaid, shall be thenceforth applicable to the payment of the current expenses of the said county.

SEC. 2.
