

ORPHANS COURT.

AN ACT to increase the pay of the Judges of the Orphans Court in the Counties of Baltimore, Dorchester and Washington.—1818, ch. 45.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Allowance increased.
That from and after the passage of this act, each judge of the orphans court for the counties of Baltimore, Dorchester and Washington, be and he is hereby entitled to receive, in lieu of his present per diem, the sum of three dollars for every day's attendance.

PEOPLE OF COLOUR.

A further SUPPLEMENT TO AN ACT, entitled, an Act relating to the People of Colour in this State, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and eighty-one.—1833, ch. 162.

WHEREAS, by the act, entitled, an act relating to the people Preamble.
of colour in this state, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and eighty-one, the proportion of tax to be paid by Baltimore city and county, was not accurately defined; therefore,

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Levy on the county \$1,297 86.
That the commissioners of Baltimore county shall annually hereafter levy and collect upon the taxable property of said county, without the limits of the city of Baltimore, the sum of one thousand two hundred and ninety-seven dollars and eighty-six cents, and the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall annually hereafter levy and collect upon the taxable property of said city the sum of one thousand nine hundred and forty-six dollars and eighty cents, to carry into effect the provisions On the city \$1,946 80.
of the act to which this is a supplement.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That if the commissioners of Baltimore county, and the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall on or before the first day of July next, pay into the treasury of this state the sums respectively due by them, under the provisions of the eighth section of the act above referred to, that is to say, two thousand five hundred and ninety-five dollars and seventy-two cents, by the said commissioners, and three thousand eight hundred and ninety-three dollars and sixty cents by the mayor and city council, the same shall be considered as a full release of all claims for arrearages against the said city and county, due under the provisions of the aforesaid act. On condition of payment by 1st of July.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners and the said mayor and city council are hereby authorized to levy and collect on the taxable property of the said city and county respectively, the sums necessary to carry into effect the provi- To be allowed as in full.
