SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, 30 cents That it shall and may be lawful for the sheriffs of Dorchester, per day allowed. Cecil, Kent, Caroline, Calvert, Montgomery, Saint Mary's, Charles, and Somerset counties, to ask, demand, and receive, for keeping prisoner in gaol, and finding him victuals, thirty cents per day, in lieu of the sum now allowed, to be levied and collected according to law.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall continue and Duration. be in force for one year, and until the end of the next session of the general assembly thereafter.
