appeals, and receive and make further changes of property if necessary, of which said meeting reasonable notice shall be given in the discretion of said court, who shall, as soon thereafter as may be, cause the annual levy to be made out, and in addition to the number of copies of said levy now required by law to be made, it shall be the duty of said clerk to make a list. alphabetically arranged, specifying the names of the taxable inhabitants of said county, the amount of property assessed to each, and the rate of levy upon said property, which list shall be delivered to the clerk of the county court on or before the first Monday in August in each and every year, whose duty it shall be to suspend or deposite the same in the clerk's office in some conspicuous place, accessible to, and subject to the examination and inspection of, any person interested therein, without fee or reward.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said clerk shall receive Compensafor his services such compensation as said levy court shall tion to think reasonable and proper, and shall be removable at the pleasure of said court, provided that in no one year shall a greater sum than two hundred dollars be allowed.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That in all other respects not Powers specifically designated as changed and altered by the provi-levy court sions of this act, the laws relative to the powers, duties and alone. conduct, of the levy court and commissioners of the tax, shall be construed to extend to the levy court alone, and the office of the commissioners of the tax for said county, and all laws repugnant to the provisions of this act, are abolished and repealed.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the Books to clerk of the commissioners of the tax for said county, or such be delivered over. person or persons having charge of the books and papers belonging to the commissioners of the tax, to deliver over to the clerk of the levy court for said county the books and papers belonging to said commissioners, under a penalty of five hundred dollars for refusal so to do, which penalty shall be recovered by indictment, for the use of the county.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, Lovy and That the levy court of Charles county, be, and they are hereby allowance. authorized and empowered to levy and allow to the clerk of that body, such sum as may be deemed by them an adequate compensation for his services; Provided, that not more than three hundred dollars be allowed for any one year.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said court may, in their For past discretion, allow such additional compensation to the clerk, for year.
