for the use of the criers aforesaid, not exceeding one dollar per day for every day that the register of wills, and clerk of the county, shall certify that the said crier acted as such.

ELECTIONS.

An Acr to fix the compensation of Judges and Clerks of Elections in and for Dorchester County.-1827, ch. 16.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Compensafrom and after the passage of this act, that judges and clerks of elections respectively in and for Dorchester county, shall perform the duties required by law now in force, and shall be allowed, and entitled to receive for each election at which he shall attend, and for making the returns, the sum of three dollars per day, to be levied and paid as other county charges; any law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

FENCES.

An Acr to repeal an Act, entitled, an Act regulating Fences in Dorchester and Caroline Counties, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter one hundred and nineteen, and the Supplement thereto, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter two hundred and twenty-five, so far as they relate to Dorchester County.—1834, ch. 57.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Repeal. the act, entitled, an act regulating fences in Dorchester and Caroline counties, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter one hundred and nineteen, and the supplement thereto, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter two hundred and twenty-five, be and the same are hereby repealed, so far as they relate to Dorchester county.

FERRIES.

A SUPPLEMENT to the Act, entitled, an additional Supplement to the Act, entitled, an Act to regulate Public Ferries.-1825, ch. 5.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, Powers That the justices of the levy court of Dorchester county, are vested in the levy hereby vested with all the powers and authority given to the court of Dorchester county court of Dorchester, by the act to which this is a supplement, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-one; and that after the passage of this act, the powers of the said county court, with regard to making contracts for keeping public ferries at the county expense, is hereby abrogated and made void.
