Sec. 4. Gives compensation to commissioners.

Duration.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall be and continue in force until the expiration of the said act to which this is a supplement.

An Acr to authorize the Levy Court of Harford County to open certain Roads.—1823, ch. 78.

Levy court authorized.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Harford county, if they in their judgment deem it expedient, be, and they are hereby authorized to cause to be laid out and opened any road or roads which hereafter may be applied for under a supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to public roads in the several counties therein mentioned, passed at December session, 1822, chapter 18, notwithstanding such road or roads may pass on the route or bed laid out by the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company.

Assent of the Turnpike company. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the assent of the president and directors of said turnpike company, shall first be given to opening such road or roads.

Remunera-

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said company shall when they turnpike such road, pay Harford county the full amount of damages awarded to landholders, and also the sum of money expended in opening such road.

Repeal.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That all and every act or acts of assembly which are repugnant to, or inconsistent with the provisions of this act be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Authority to draw from treasury.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the orphans court of Harford county, be, and they are
