

AN ACT, entitled, an additional Supplement to the Act, entitled, an Act for the distribution of a certain fund for the purpose of establishing Free Schools in the several Counties therein mentioned, so far as relates to Harford County.—1834, ch. 226.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Repeat.
That so much of the second section of an act passed thirteenth of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, as directs the orphans court of Harford county, to place the school fund money of said county, in some bank or savings institution as they may receive it, be, and the same is hereby repealed, and the said orphans court are hereby authorized at their discretion to invest any surplus money in their hands belonging to the said school fund, in the manner they may deem most advantageous for the augmentation of said fund. Investment authorized.

No law can be found in 1833—it is presumed that it refers to that of 1832, ch. 160, sec. 2.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the orphans court of said county, shall after the passage of this act, require the register of wills of said county, to keep a separate and distinct account with each commissioner of the school fund of said county, for all receipts and disbursements. District associates required.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That if any commissioner of the school fund of said county, shall neglect or refuse to settle his or their account or accounts, as is required by existing laws with the orphans court of said county, for six months after the time required by law, it shall then be the duty of said orphans court, and they are hereby authorized and required to remove such delinquent commissioner or commissioners forthwith, and appoint some other duly qualified person or persons in his or their stead. Commissioners neglecting. Removal directed.

AN ACT for the distribution of School Moneys and the encouragement of Schools and Teachers in Harford County.—1837, ch. 247.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Orphans court to draw income annually.
That the orphans court of Harford county shall draw on the treasurer of the western shore annually, in the second week in July, for such portion of the increase of the income of that part of the surplus revenue received from the government of the United States, of which the interest has been pledged by the state for purposes of education, as Harford county shall be entitled to receive; and shall also draw as aforesaid for the share which Harford county is entitled to receive of the income arising from the free school fund, and for the said county's share of any fund appropriated, or hereafter to be appropriated for school purposes. And free school fund.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said orphans court shall apportion the said funds, when so drawn for, as mentioned in proceeds.
