SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the office of commissioners Commisand inspectors of primary schools, in Kent county, be, and the sioners and inspectors' same is hereby abolished, and that the trustees of primary office schools in each election district of said county, or a majority of them, are hereby constituted a board of commissioners, in- Trustees to vested with and empowered to exercise all the functions and be commisduties of commissioners and inspectors, except the examination Powers. of teachers, and that the trustees of each school district shall have all the powers necessary to the examination, approval and employment of teachers, in their respective school districts, which were given to the commissioners and inspectors for that purpose, in the original act to which this is a supplement.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the Duty of board of trustees in each election district, or any one of the trustees to trustees in said election district, may exercise the power, to meetings. call district meetings as soon as convenient, in all the school districts in their respective election districts, where schools have not been organized and carried into operation, to make notice in writing, describing such district, and appointing a Notice.
