AN ACT for the re-valuation of Real and Personal Property in Montgomery County.—1830, ch. 53.

Re-assessment of property.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the present commissioners of the tax of Montgomery county be, and they are hereby authorized and required to meet at Rockville, in said county, as soon as may be practicable after the passage of this act, and there proceed to re-value and re-assess the real and personal property in the said county, agreeably to the provisions of an act passed at November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled, an act for the valuation of real and personal property in the several counties in this state.

Acts to be carried into effect.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners of the tax for Montgomery county are hereby authorized and empowered to carry into full effect and operation all the provisions of this act, as well as the aforesaid act of eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled, an act for the valuation of real and personal property in the several counties of this state.
