Sec. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, Annual ap-That from and after the passage of this act, the governor, by pointment of five comand with the advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint, missioners. and he is hereby required annually to appoint five persons, citizens of Montgomery county, one of whom shall reside in One from each of the election districts of said county, to be called the each district commissioners for Montgomery county, and in case of a va- Case of cancy occasioned by the death, resignation, refusal to act or vacancy. removal out of the county, of either of said commissioners, the governor shall supply such vacancy occasioned by such death, resignation, refusal or removal, as the case may be.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That each commissioner shall, Oath of before he enters upon the duties of his office, take and sub-office. scribe such oath or affirmation as is now required by law to be made and subscribed by the justices of the levy court and commissioners of the tax of said county, which oaths shall be kept among the records of Montgomery county court.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the commissioners appointed Board inas aforesaid, and their successors, shall be, and they are hereby corporated. constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name and title Name and of the commissioners for Montgomery county, and by that name style. shall have continual and perpetual succession, and be capable Powers and in law of suing and being sued, of making and using a cor-duties. porate seal, and of altering the same, and of doing all such acts as may be necessary to the exercise of all the powers and duties which are required by law to be done and performed. by the levy court and commissioners of the tax of said county, respectively.

B. do swear, or Oath affirm, that, as clerk of the commissioners for Montgomery required. county, I will honestly and faithfully, to the best of my skill and judgment, execute the duties of said office without favour, affection or prejudice, so help me God: which oath, or affirmation, any one of said commissioners is hereby authorized to
