

Recorded. administer, and said oath shall be recorded in the clerk's office of Montgomery county court, and the said clerk shall also be subjected to the same penalties and forfeitures for non-performance, or neglect of official duty, as are prescribed by the existing laws in relation to the respective offices of clerk of the levy court and commissioners of the tax.

Case of vacancy of clerk. **SEC. 5.** *And be it enacted,* That in case of a vacancy in the office of clerk to the commissioners, as created by this act, by death, resignation, removal or disqualification, the same shall be supplied by the said commissioners as soon thereafter as may be practicable.

His compensation \$3 00. **SEC. 6.** *And be it enacted,* That the said clerk shall receive three dollars for every day he shall attend the session of said commissioners, and such further compensation for official duties performed on other days as may be allowed by said commissioners, and the said clerk shall be removable at the discretion of the commissioners.
