

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That when and as soon as the commissioners to be appointed by this act shall have taken and subscribed the oath or affirmation herein before directed, all the powers, rights and privileges lawfully exercised by, and all property, estates and effects vested in the levy court of Montgomery county, or in the commissioners of the tax for said county shall be transferred to, and vested in the commissioners for Montgomery county, who, or any three of them, shall exercise all the rights, powers and privileges, and perform all the duties required by law to be performed by the levy court of said county and the commissioners of tax, and no appointment of justices of the levy court shall hereafter be made.

Powers and duties transferred.

Boards to cease.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That not less than three commissioners shall form a board for the transaction of business, any two of whom may decide upon all matters coming before them; but the concurrence of three of said commissioners shall be necessary in directing the payment of money, or in making appointments to office; and the said commissioners shall receive two dollars per day, for each and every day they shall attend to the duties of their office, when the duties thereof require them, and six cents for every mile they shall necessarily travel, from their residence to the place where they shall meet; *Provided*, that no commissioner shall be allowed more than one charge for mileage as aforesaid, when they shall meet on two or more successive days.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners shall meet on the first Monday of April annually, and shall continue to sit from day to day, for one week, for the transaction of such business as may be brought before them, and shall also have power to adjourn from time to time, and sit such number of days as may be necessary for the discharge of all the duties required of them.

Annual session.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That all suits at law, or in equity, which may be pending at the time of the passage of this act, in which the levy court of Montgomery county are parties, shall be carried on in like manner, and have the same effect and operation in law as if the commissioners appointed by this act had been one of the original parties to said suit or suits.

Pending suits provided for.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That all acts of Assembly which are contrary to, or inconsistent with the provisions of this act be, and the same are hereby repealed.
